Higher Level Responsibilities

- To provide cover and release for class teachers.
- To develop appropriate planning for short term cover in classes
- To support and direct classroom staff accordingly.
- To take responsibility for implementing and facilitating sessions.
- To support class based staff in following individual programmes, e.g. toileting, behaviour.
- To provide feedback to the class teacher on a regular basis

Specific Tasks and Duties

- Attend to pupils' personal needs, and implement related personal programmes, including social, health, physical, hygiene, first aid and welfare matters.
- Supervise and support pupils ensuring their safety and access to learning.
- Establish good relationships with pupils, acting as a role model and being aware of and responding appropriately to individual needs.
- Promote the inclusion and acceptance of all pupils.
- Encourage pupils to interact with others and engage in activities led by the teacher.
- Encourage pupils to act independently as appropriate.
- Undertake pupils' record keeping as requested.
- Support colleagues in managing pupil behaviour and implementing behaviour programmes, reporting difficulties as appropriate.
- Gather information on pupils as requested.
